

## Take Your Best Shot – Esko Nature Photography Contest

**Who:** any student presently attending Esko School District in grades 7 – 12.

**What:** submit up to three of your best digital nature photos for any or all months of the contest. Images must be taken during the month you are interested in submitting for. Example, the best photo for October must have been taken during the month of October.

**When:** September 2008 – August 2009; a winner will be chosen for each month of the year with a grand prize photo being chosen from the monthly winners in September 2009.

**How:** see submission guidelines below

**Monthly Winners:** each monthly winner will receive an exclusive “Nature Photography Contest” t-shirt with the above logo (logo designed by our own Mr. Kemptar)

### **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

Enter up to three images per month of outdoor landscapes, close-ups, etc. One photo will be chosen each month as a finalist. Contest entries will be judged on technical quality, composition, originality, and artistic merit. All photographs should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared in the viewfinder. Nothing should be added to an image and nothing should be removed. Cropping and minor adjustments to electronic images is acceptable.

**SUBMISSION DROP-BOX:** the **submission drop box** must be used for your digital submissions.

**Upload and Submit**

**DEADLINE:** Entries will be accepted beginning at 12:00am the first day of each month and up to 11:59pm the last night of the month.

**DIGITAL ENTRIES:** Please send digitally captured images taken at the camera's highest resolution (preferably RAW capture). Send your entries in these formats:

- Highest Resolution
- Largest Size
- JPG or JPEG format only!

If your computer bogs down using the Drop-Box, Burn your images on a cd or flash drive and bring to school for submission.

**DIGITAL IMAGE FILE NAMES:** It is important to name each electronic image file with your first and last name—this is how we track your images. The best way to do this is to use the “save as” command in your image management program. Highlight the image file name and rename it with your FIRST and LAST name and a one- or two-word brief title description of your subject then save as a jpeg. Do not have spaces in your name, instead, use ( \_ ) between words. (Example: johndoe\_lion.jpeg)

**YOUR SUBMISSION MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

1. IMAGES. Limit of three per month.
2. LIST OF CAPTIONS AND CAMERA SPECIFICATIONS. Send or email a typed list of the following information for each image: (\* = required information)
3. TITLE: Common name of subject or species (Latin name not necessary).
4. LOCATION: Formal name of garden/park/forest/preserve, city, state or province, and country.
5. YOUR NAME (as you would like it to be published) and your city, state or province, and country.
6. CAPTION: Describe (up to 100 words) the natural history of your subject; the behavior displayed; the challenge of getting the shot and how it was resolved; the unique gear, preparation, or photographic set-up used; and perhaps a humorous anecdote about getting the shot.

(optional) CAMERA body, manufacturer, and model.

(optional) LENS (for zoom lens, include focal length used); Lens accessories (filters, tele-extendors, extension tubes).

(optional) SHUTTER SPEED.

(optional) APERTURE setting.

(optional) ISO setting.

(optional) FLASH: manufacturer and model, settings such as ‘full’, ‘fill’; Flash accessories (remote triggers, extendors): manufacturer, model.

(optional) TRIPOD (or car window mounts, bean bags, etc.): manufacturer and model; Tripod head: manufacturer and model.

If UNDERWATER: camera, housing, and strobes: manufacturer and model for each.

Using the Drop-Box is preferred but if you must - MAIL TO:
